4	This Act may be cited as the "Local Transit Planning
5	Support Act".

10 "(f) GOVERNMENT SHARE OF COSTS.—

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1	"(1) In general.—Except as provided in para-
2	graph (2)(A), the Government share of the cost of
3	an activity funded using amounts made available
4	under this section may not exceed 80 percent of the
5	cost of the activity unless the Secretary determines
6	that it is in the interests of the Government—
7	"(A) not to require a State or local match;
8	or
9	"(B) to allow a Government share greater
10	than 80 percent.
11	"(2) CERTAIN ACTIVITIES.—
12	"(A) In General.—The Government
13	share of the cost of an activity funded using
14	amounts made available under this section shall
15	be not less than 90 percent for an activity that
16	assists parts of an urbanized area or rural area
17	with lower population density or lower average
18	income levels compared to—
19	"(i) the applicable urbanized area;
20	"(ii) the applicable rural area;
21	"(iii) an adjoining urbanized area; or
22	"(iv) an adjoining rural area.
23	"(B) Report.—A State or metropolitan

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creased Government share described in that subparagraph shall report to the Secretary, in a form as determined by the Secretary, how the increased Government share for transportation planning activities benefits commuting and other essential travel in parts of the applicable urbanized area or rural area described in subparagraph (A) with lower population density or lower average income levels."
