Dear Postmaster Louis DeJoy,

We are writing to express our concern over the poor physical condition of the United States Post Office located at 115 S Main St, Greensboro, GA 30642. The building is located in the county seat of Greene County, Georgia and has become an eyesore and potential safety hazard in the downtown. We strongly request that the United States Postal Service (USPS) take immediate steps to remedy the situation.

The post office is located in the heart of downtown Greensboro, which has experienced rapid growth and development in recent years. The post office building has not kept up with neighboring buildings in appearance but has avoided potential municipal fines since it falls under the jurisdiction of the federal government. Attached are recent photographs of the building, which demonstrate the need for attention and improvement by the Postal Service.

We request that the USPS review the attached photographs, inspect the property, and address the deficiencies with the building's appearance. We further request the USPS respond within 30 days, detailing its plan to address these deficiencies.
