To extend the authority of the Department of the Army to carry out a child development center project in Fort Gordon, Georgia.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Fort Gordon Child
5 Development Center Expansion Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY TO CARRY OUT FORT**
 2 **GORDON CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER**
 3 **PROJECT.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding section 2002 of
 5 the Military Construction Authorization Act for Fiscal
 6 Year 2021 (division B of Public Law 116–283; 134 Stat.
 7 4294), the authorization under section 2865 of that Act
 8 (10 U.S.C. 2802 note) for the project described in sub-
 9 section (b) in Fort Gordon, Georgia, shall remain in effect
 10 until October 1, 2024, or the date of the enactment of
 11 an Act authorizing funds for military construction for fis-
 12 cal year 2025, whichever is later.

13 (b) PROJECT DESCRIBED.—The project described in
 14 this subsection is the following:
