1SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY TO CARRY OUT FORT2GORDON CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER3PROJECT.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding section 2002 of 5 the Military Construction Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2021 (division B of Public Law 116–283; 134 Stat. 6 7 4294), the authorization under section 2865 of that Act 8 (10 U.S.C. 2802 note) for the project described in subsection (b) in Fort Gordon, Georgia, shall remain in effect 9 10 until October 1, 2024, or the date of the enactment of an Act authorizing funds for military construction for fis-11 12 cal year 2025, whichever is later.
