Dear Chair McReynolds,

I write to draw your urgent attention to yet another recent precipitous decline in on-time mail delivery for my constituents in Georgia. I write further to request an immediate briefing on the status of efforts to replace former Postmaster General DeJoy. My constituents, and I cannot emphasize this strongly enough, are beside themselves at the consistent and recurring failure of USPS leadership to execute their basic mission in Georgia.

Current on-time delivery statistics in Georgia remain well below 2023 levels. The failed transition to the Palmetto Regional Processing and Distribution Center has resulted in disastrous mail service for my constituents. They continue to report delayed service. The absence of a Postmaster General leaves USPS without direction and the urgency necessary to ensure timely delivery.

Georgians deserve reliable on-time mail delivery, and competent leadership that will deliver results. I once again urge you to swiftly appoint a new Postmaster General who will completely correct the abysmal failure of Postmaster General DeJoy's Delivering for America program. His successor must be hired on merit, not political connections to the President. Thank you for your attention to this urgent matter.
