Dear Secretary Collins,

I write to urge quick execution of funding provided in the Fiscal Year (FY) 2026 VA Appropriations bill to establish a veterans cemetery in Augusta, Georgia through the Veterans Cemetery Grants Program. Augusta is home to over 66,000 military veterans and many military families. The closest veterans cemeteries to Augusta are in Milledgeville, GA, and Columbia, SC, both of which are 80 miles away. The establishment of a veterans cemetery in Augusta would support the National Cemetery Administration's goal of providing veterans reasonable access to burial benefits within 75 miles of the veterans' home. Augusta's veterans deserve the access to these benefits a cemetery in Augusta would provide.

Per information provided to the Senate Appropriations Subcommittee on Military Construction and Veterans' Affairs (MilCon-VA), it is my understanding that the levels provided to the Grants for the Construction of Veterans Cemeteries account, an increase of \$90 million over the President's \$60 million Budget Request, should be sufficient to fund the establishment of a veterans cemetery in Augusta, based on its current priority ranking for FY26.³ I stand by ready to provide any additional information or support you may require in moving forward with this critical initiative.

Thank you for your attention to this matter and I look forward to your continued partnership in supporting Georgia's veterans.
